1. What is the date, location, and time of the reunion?

3. What is the cost to attend the reunion? When is the payment deadline?

\$77.00 due by Wednesday, May 22, 2024. Reservation and payment required for all attendees.

Per venue requirements, NO SAME DAY registration and payment accepted on June 22, the day of the reunion.

Reserve a table for 10. Reserve early. Seating is limited.

4. How do I register and pay for the lunch if I do not have a computer or a printer?

5. What does my payment cover for this reunion?

- Lunch served to you at your table
- A choice of 3 entrées, beverage choice of coffee, tea and water, and a venue selected dessert
- Venue room rental, table linens, set-up, and clean-up
- Complimentary parking
- Sound system set-up and rental
- Dance floor and music
- Badges, centerpieces, directional signage, and graphics
- Photo booth
- Cash bar: bartender service, cash, credit card and/or debit card payments accepted
- Meal cost for band members, faculty, and invited special guests

6. What will be served for lunch?

There is a choice of 3 entrées (Select one)

- Carne Asada: Marinated and grilled beef with fresh Jicama and Pico de Gallo
- Chicken Picatta: Flavorful chicken marinated in spices and topped with a lemon garlic caper sauce
- Pasta Primavera: Penne pasta with assorted julienne of vegetables topped with marinara sauce

Each entrée comes with a green salad (with choice of 2 dressings), sour dough roll, tea, coffee or water and a dessert.

Outside food and drinks are not allowed on the premises. Smoking is not permitted on the property.

12. What is the weather forecast in June for this reunion?

13. Where will the reunion be held at in the Quiet Cannon facility?

The dining room is located on the 2nd floor of the main building. There are two elevators and stairways leading up to the room. Restrooms are located on the same floor next to the room.

14. When I arrive at the Quiet Cannon, how do I sign in for the reunion?

Come to the registration tables set up on the 2nd floor. It will be organized by class year. A badge will be issued to you. A card that specifies your entrée selection will be given to you. The lunch server will be looking for this card at your table setting, to serve you your choice of meal. One complimentary raffle ticket will be given to each attendee. The tables will be arranged by class years. If you booked a table for 10, a table will be reserved for your party.

15. Is there handicap access to the dining room?

There are large space elevators to help you get you up to the 2nd floor room which has double door entrances.

If you need additional assistance, please let us know in advance. Handicap parking is available next to the building.

16. Can we golf at the Quiet Cannon/Montebello Golf Course?

Yes. Topgolf Los Angeles – Montebello grand opened May 3rd. The redesigned Montebello 9-hole executive golf course is also open. We recommend you make a reservation early at the new 3 story Topgolf venue that includes a sports bar and restaurant. - 19. Will there be photos taken at the reunion?**
We have a photo booth. Backdrops and props from the Sentinel Centennial All Class picnic will also be set up for you to view and take photos. Show your school spirit by wearing/bringing your Lettermen jackets/sweaters and class sweaters. Wear green and black. The program will include a Letterman challenge. Show us you can still fit into your Letterman jacket or class sweater. Which class has the fittest alumni?
- 20. Will there be a raffle? Can I donate?**
One complimentary raffle ticket will be given to each attendee. You can purchase more tickets. \$2 per ticket or \$5 for 3 tickets. All monies collected will be donated to the BHS Alumni Association for student scholarships which are awarded yearly to deserving seniors to help them pay for college expenses. - 21. Will there be music and dancing?**
An alumni band is being organized. Any talented alumni singers available? We will have karaoke. Dancing music from the 60's will be played in the background. There is no formal dance activity. We have a dance floor so you can show off the Twist.
- 22. When was the BHS Sentinel Centennial celebration held?**
The school celebrated its 100th birthday on Monday, September 11, 2023. The school opened its doors in 1923. There was a varsity football game at Erdmann Stadium against our rival Marshall High School. Robert Lyles '79 (who played 8 seasons with the Houston Oilers and the Atlanta Falcons) initiated the coin toss at the game. It was the largest paid ticket attendance in the history of the school. The proceeds went to support the BHS Associated Students activities. Alumni musicians returned to play in the band. An All-Class picnic and a ceremony was held at the school.
- Award winning song writer Mike Stoller W'50 was the honorary alumni. With his songwriting partner Jerry Leiber, they wrote hit songs from the 50's and 60's including Elvis's songs "Jail House Rock" and "Hound Dog." Original Tommy's was the official sponsor of the Centennial. Tommy's is the official burger of BHS voted by the student council in 1983. The Alumni Association received a generous donation from Cindi Koulax, Original Tommy's Vice President, and the youngest daughter of Tommy's founder Tom Koulax. (1918-1992) He received an honorary BHS diploma at the 20th reunion for the Class of '66. EastsiderLA was the official media sponsor of the Centennial. There is a Centennial edition of the BHS alumni newsletter with the history of the school and Original Tommy's, and a century of distinguished Sentinels.
- 23. After the reunion ends, I want to meet with some of my classmates. Where can we go to meet?**
You can gather at the Hilton Garden Inn, right next door to the Quiet Cannon. It is within walking/driving distance. There is a restaurant and a no-host bar. There are also restaurants located nearby on Via San Clemente, across the street from the entrance driveway to the Quiet Cannon. (in the former 99 Cent store parking lot)
- 24. Is there a place nearby to go shopping and to eat?**
Costco (on Market Place Drive), In-n-out, Chick-fil-A, Buffalo Wild Wings, Mod Pizza, and the Shops at Montebello are at the Paramount Blvd. exit off the 60 Fwy. There is a food court along with Applebee's, BJ's, Carl's Jr., Taco Bell, and a 10 screen AMC theatre. shops@montebello.com
